



BOOKING CONDITIONS

The committee and members of Leeds Golf Club wish to welcome you and ask that as the organiser of your visiting party you note these simple conditions to make your day as enjoyable as possible.

GREEN FEES

ALL GREEN FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU PLAY.

Only in special circumstances AND by prior arrangement may payment be made by way of account other than on the day of play. Green fees are inclusive of V.A.T.

TEE RESERVATION

The tee is normally available for visitors as follows:

Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

After 9.00am and from 1.36pm

Tuesday and Thursday

Morning by prior arrangement and after 1.36pm

Saturday

After 2.30pm for small groups and subject to availability.

Sunday

After 2.00pm for small groups, excluding club competition days.

All these times refer to the **SUMMER** months and there will be variations in the Winter. The **BOOKING FORM** must be returned even if the exact details of your visit, i.e. number of players are not fully known. Tee times will be confirmed in due course.

All play will be from the **YELLOW** tees markers, even when a Club Member is in your party. Please also note that Club Members in your party may not sign in guests at the reduced concessionary rate.

TYPE OF GAME - SPEED OF PLAY.

All individual competition shall be Stableford or Medal and will only be allowed in 2 ball or 3 ball matches. The only type of 4 ball games allowed are BetterBall or Teams games with 2 scores to count.

Texas Scramble and other Team games are not allowed. All visitors and guests should be aware of their speed of play. Slow play is a major concern to all golfers.

ETIQUETTE AND DRESS RULES

All your players are expected to know the rules of golf as well as the etiquette of the game.

**MOBILE PHONES ARE, RESTRICTED IN THE CLUBHOUSE AND ON THE COURSE AND MUST BE SWITCHED TO SILENT AT ALL TIMES.
PLEASE SEE THE NOTICES IN THE CLUB HOUSE FOR MOBILE USE.**

BRIEF DRESS CODE

- On the golf course all clothing MUST be of a type accepted as 'golf clothing' within a members club such as ours. In addition shirts MUST be tucked into trousers at the waist.
 - Gentlemen must NOT wear headgear of any description in the Clubhouse unless for religious reasons.
 - Jeans and denim clothing of all types, training type shoes as well as collarless shirts are NOT permitted, either on the course or in the clubhouse.
 - Tailored shorts with either long or short white socks are permitted on the course at all times and in the clubhouse until 7.00pm.
 - Clubhouse dress rules are Smart Casual (dry) clothing in all rooms.
 - The Club reserves the right to request any visitor not complying with the rules to leave the course or clubhouse.
1. At the time of your booking you will be asked for a non refundable deposit.
 2. All 'NO SHOWS' will lose their deposit. Final numbers MUST be confirmed at least 5 days prior to the visit. Failure to confirm may result in the day being offered to another group. Catering requirements must also be confirmed at this time. Meals ordered are meals paid for.
