

**LEEDS GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES**

**1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27 applies)**

- a) Beyond all boundary walls, fences, hedges and railings.
- b) In the Clubhouse enclosure, including practice putting green and paddock, defined by white posts.
- c) In the car park enclosure.
- d) On or over the entrance drive at the 2nd hole. NB. The chain fence to the right of the 2nd hole does NOT define Out of Bounds.

**2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26-1 applies)**

- a) The cross ditches on the 1st, 3rd and 4th holes are Water Hazards, defined by yellow posts.
- b) All other ditches are Lateral Water Hazards, defined by red posts.

**3. STONES IN BUNKERS** are Movable Obstructions. (Rule 24-1 applies).

**4. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE**

- a) Hole Indicator Stones.
- b) Bridges.

The ball must be played as it lies or relief taken under penalty (Ball Unplayable).

**5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2 applies)**

- a) The Public Footpaths which cross the 8th and 10th holes. (Relief can be taken under Rule 24-2b(i) if a ball comes to rest on or within the marked blue boxed areas).
- b) The paths to the left of the 15th fairway.
- c) All manufactured paths.

**6. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES (Identified by stakes)**

If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b(i) (Immovable Obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

**7. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS**

All fixed sprinkler heads are Immovable Obstructions and relief from them is available under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction, on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention and c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

**8. PRACTICE**

On any day of a strokeplay competition the Committee permits practice on the course, but only in the designated area between the ditch on the 1st hole and the grip to the right of the 2nd hole.

**PENALTY FOR BREACH OF THOSE LOCAL RULES NOT COVERED BY A RULE OF GOLF:**

**MATCH PLAY - LOSS OF HOLE;  
STROKE PLAY - TWO STROKES.**
